veterinarian have the authority to examine and
disqualify any entries for cruelty or unsoundness.
3. Entrants do not have to be members of the NASMA
to show except for amateur entries. Amateur entries
must exhibit NASMA registered mules in their name
or immediate family members' name. See NASMA
rules for details.
4. Amateur exhibitors must present NASMA amateur
card at time of entry, and copy of NASMA
reigstration papers.
5. Mules do not to be registered with NASMA to
show, howevre all junior mules must present either
registration or mouthing certificate from veterinarian
to verify age.
6. In order to qualify for NASMA year end high point
awards, the mule must be registered with NASMA
and both owner and exhibitor must be members of
NASMA.
7. Youth Exhibitors - 18 and under as of 1/1/11
8. All exhibitors must obtain a release from Feeders
Supply Company and the North American
International Livestock Exposition before leaving
grounds.
9. Bottom hole 30" from the ground and the top hole at
a minimum of 72".

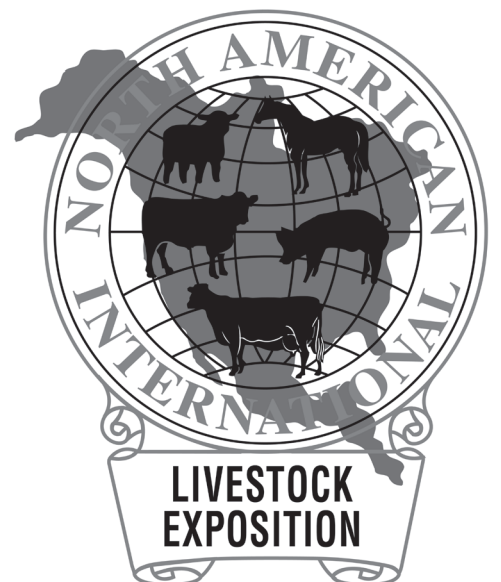
As stated in the entry application, the Kentucky State Fair Board (KSFB) requires personally identifiable information, including a social security number, for process of entry applications and payment if applicable. The KSFB shall only have access to compile information that is voluntarily provided by applicants on the entry application form. The KSFB gives its assurances that it will not sell, share, exchange or otherwise provide information obtained from the entry application form to any person, entity or third party outside of the KSFB. Only those authorized KSFB employees will have access to the entry application forms for business purposes (process of entry applications and payment if applicable). Further, the computer server on which entry application forms are maintained remains secure at all times.

1. Exhibitors are requested to familiarize themselves with all the rules of show applicable to their exhibits.
 2. Every mule or donkey entered must pay a \$40.00 stall fee for the duration of the show. Exhibitors must check in with the Stall personnel (located by Barn (O) before picking up packet with numbers. Stalls will be assigned to you upon arrival.
 3. Each exhibitor must have a pass or pay admission and parking to the grounds.

 5. **Money Paid on Composite Placings:** In all classes the money awards will be determined based on composite placing of both judges; ribbons awarded on both judges.
 6. **Entries Closing Date** - All entries must be postmarked on or before October 28, 2011. Postage meter date not accepted.
 7. **Post Entries** - will be accepted, entry fee \$25.00 per class, until 6:00 p.m. the day before the class is to be held.
 8. **Entry Forms** - The entry form must contain all information requested including complete mailing address, social security number and signature. Your entry form must be neat and correct.

9. You will not be allowed to show without the following: Health Certificates will be required on all mules and donkeys, in state within 150 days and out of state within 30 days. Every animal must have a certificate of equine infectious anemia test within the past 12 months and you must bring your paper to the show. We must see both sides.
10. All dogs must be tied up in barn area or on a leash. Keep dogs out of the show arena.
11. Fire Marshal prohibits hook-ups of motor homes in barn area. This regulation will be enforced.
12. Vans and trailers must be parked in designated areas only. RV reservations can be made by calling (502) 367-5384.
13. Tack or feed stalls are available at \$40.00.
14. No refunds on entry or stall fee will be made where a mule or donkey is withdrawn by an exhibitor for any reason.
15. No livestock (for exhibit or sale) will be released until the exhibitor presents a paid feed bill and obtains a release from the Horse Show Office.
16. The Show Management, Representative or Judge must disqualify a contestant if he enters the arena with any equipment illegal in a contest. All entry fees and/or premiums pertaining to said contestant shall be forfeited.
17. All entries for exhibits of any kind or character are subject to these regulations and any violation will subject exhibitors to any penalties by the Executive Committee.

18. The management reserves the right to accept or reject entirely, partially or conditionally any entry or application. The management also reserves the right to personally, or appoint a committee to, inspect all entries after they have arrived, and dismiss any entries that would discredit the Exposition.
19. Exhibitors will be required to attend to their animals while on exhibition and to have them presented to the judges when called. Any exhibitor who fails to present his animals in the ring when the class is called to be judged will be barred from the competition.
20. False representation, interference, or ungentlemanly like conduct by an exhibitor will be dealt with by the Executive Committee.
21. Judges will not award prizes to any unworthy exhibit. Animals must be shown in such a manner as the judges require and if the exhibitors refuse to submit to the requirements of the judges, their animals will be dismissed.
22. All animals must be exhibited before the judges in the show ring, with exhibitor number attached.
23. Premiums will be forwarded to the exhibitors as they may direct, as soon after the close of the Exposition as they can be properly processed. Premiums are payable by bank check. All premiums whatsoever, not claimed by November 1 of the following year, shall be deemed forfeitable to the management or donors.
24. All protests must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$500.00 which will be forfeited if protest is not sustained. Such protest must be delivered to the Manager within six hours after the occasion of such protest, or if age is brought into question, one day, prior to the one on which the animals are to be judged. Protests will be considered by the Executive Committee as speedily as possible and their decision in the matter shall be final.

6. High Point/Reserve High Point awards to: Junior, Senior, Youth, Amateur, Gymkhana and Gaited.
7. Youth Exhibitors - 18 and under as of 1/1/11.
