ABGA SANCTION RULES SHALL GOVERN

1. All entries and awards in this department will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in the Premium List and also to the following rules.
2. **Entries:** The show shall be open to all exhibitors. There is a limit of four animals that can be entered in an individual class by an exhibitor and only two premiums per class per exhibitor.
3. **Eligibility of Animals:** All goats must be registered in the Herd Book of a recognized association. Recognized associations include ABGA, CBGA, USBGA, and IBGA. The original registration certificate is required. Animals must be registered and owned on or before November 1.
4. **Ennobled Herd Book Points:** Goats entered under its ABGA registration number and presenting a valid ABGA Certificate of Registration will be eligible to earn points for their actual placing under the AGBA ennobled program.

5. **Tattoos:** All goats must have legible tattoo(s) or other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate or their animal will be disqualified. The top 5 in the classes plus the Champion & Reserve must have their tattoos read and recorded. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.
6. **Computing Ages:** Birth dates, as listed on the registration certificate, will be used to determine the class divisions. The base date is the date of show.
7. **Classes:** All animals must be registered purebred, fullblood or percentage blood boer goats. Percentage doe classes are for goats 50% to 87.5% (1/2 to 7/8 blood) Boer; Fullblood classes are for does that are 15/16 blood (93.7%) and higher; and 31/32 blood (96.8%) and higher for bucks. Progeny of fresh does will **NOT** be allowed in the ring. The Champion and Reserve classes will be chosen from the first and second place animals in that division of the show.
8. **Disqualification:** Any goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from the show in any of the breeding classes. Artificial coloring will be a disqualification. Illegible tattoos or tattoos inconsistent with registration papers will result in disqualification. Any doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
9. Only one person per goat is permitted in the ring. Heelers will be allowed in the Group Classes and Yearling Classes and older.
10. Substitutions are allowed in the same class only and must have the same ownership as the original entry. Please make substitutions at check in. Group class entries are to be made at check in.
11. Exhibitors will receive an entry number arm band for each goat entered and must wear the correct number in the show ring.
12. **Parking, Admissions and Camping:** See information in front of this Premium List.
13. All feed and bedding must be provided by the exhibitor. It can be brought from home or purchased at the show. The furnishing of feed and bedding to other exhibitors is **NOT** allowed.
14. All goats in the barn must be entered in the show. Pen size is 7' x 7' or 5' x 5'.
15. **Health Regulations and Protests:** See General Rules.
16. Classes, judging sheets, and goats entering the show ring - BY DATE OF BIRTH - YOUNGEST TO OLDEST.

Points will be computed from fullblood classes and will be awarded only to the registered name appearing on the records of the breed associations. Animals do not have to be bred by Exhibitor. Only the exhibitors two highest placings in any one class will be counted. In case of tie, the exhibitor winning the most firsts						

will receive the award. If tie still exists, the one with the most seconds will win, etc.

- 57 **PREMIER BREEDER** - Computed from winnings: 8 points for first place; 7 points for second place; 6 points for third place; 5 points for fourth place; 4 points for fifth place; 3 points for sixth place; 2 points for seventh place; and 1 point for eighth place. Points will be computed from fullblood classes and will be awarded only to the registered name appearing on the records of the breed associations. Only the breeders two highest placings in any one class will be counted. In case of tie, the breeder winning the most firsts will receive the award. If tie still exists, the one with the most seconds will win, etc.
