High point awards to youth, amateur, junior, senior, training level donkey, open donkey, gymkhana and gaited.

*Classes 49, 52, 54 will count towards high point division according to age of mule.

Either the judges, show officials or the official NAILE veterinarian have the authority to examine and disqualify any entries for cruelty or unsoundness.

Entrants do not have to be members of the NASMA to show except amateur entries.

Amateur entries must exhibit NASMA registered mules in their name or immediate family members name. See NASMA rules for details.

Amateur exhibitors must present NASMA anateur card at time of entry and copy of NASMA registration papers.

Mules do not need to be registered with NASMA to show, however all junior mules must present either registration or mouthing certificate from veterinarian to verify age.

In order to qualify for NASMA year end high points awards, the mule must be registered with NASMA and both owner and exhibitor must be members of NASMA.

Youth Exhibitors 18 and under as of 1/1/09.

All exhibitors must obtain a release from Feeders Supply Company and the North American Internationa Livestock Exposition before leaving grounds..
