



2020 NAILE Horse Show Questions

The requirements are accurate as of September 24, 2020 and are subject to change.

- 1. Why haven't I received my prize list? Or can you mail me a prize list?**
 - a. We are not able to order prize list due to delays caused by Covid-19, prize list will be available online <https://livestockexpo.org/equineEntryInformation.html>

- 2. Who can attend the 2020 NAILE Show?**
 - a. No members of the general public are permitted on the show grounds. All persons on the show grounds are required to comply with social distancing guidelines. All persons on the show grounds may be asked to provide identification or affiliation with participants at any time and may be asked to leave.

- 3. Classes/shows not taking place at the 2020 NAILE**
 - a. **Cutting**
 - b. **Roping**
 - c. **Sorting and Team Penning**
 - d. **Mules and Donkeys**
 - e. **Draft Horses**

- 4. The Horse show office can be reached at 502-367-5300**

- 5. Horse Trailers will need to enter the Fairgrounds through gates 1 and 4**

- 6. Groups in the barns?**
 - a. Each horse is allowed 3 people
 - b. Congregating in stable areas is not permitted. Parties and party areas in the stable areas are not permitted.
 - c. Must Social distance

- 7. Trainers and/or participants must remain at least six feet (6) apart while in Horse Show Office/and in the hallway.**

- a. This may result in staff/volunteers asking trainers or participants to come back at a later time or to move to a different area to decrease the opportunity for congregation and to ensure social distancing guidelines are enforced.
- b. All those who enter the Horse Show Office must wear a mask or cloth face covering.

8. Entry Deadlines

- a. Entry Closing Date: All entries must be postmarked on or before October 19, 2020. Post Entries will be accepted (entry fee and \$25.00 late charge per horse) until 6:00 p.m. the day before the class is to be held.

9. NAILE 2020 Fees-

- a. Every horse entered must pay a \$50.00 stall fee for the duration of the show. If no stall is needed, there will be a \$10.00/horse/day jump off fee. E
- b. Drug Test - All horses entered in AQHA classes must pay \$25.00 drug testing fee and submit to testing if chosen.
- c. Office Fee- All horses will be charged a \$10.00 Office Fee

10. The Quarter Horse show will be taking place in Freedom Hall October 22-26th

11. \$225 AQHA Package includes

- a. Stall
- b. AQHA class entry fees in unlimited classes for one horse
- c. KYQHA fees
- d. Crossovers from Level 1, Youth, Amateur, and Open AQHA classes are encouraged.
- e. **Package does not include: any drug fee or office fee**
